

## The Modern Language Experiment

Tuesday 27.03.2012 7 - 8.30pm

The Modern Language Experiment was established in 2009 by Matthew Stock and Keh Ng as an artist-led contemporary art project based in East London.

It is dedicated to the development, discussion, contemplation and execution of the changing language of art today which culminise in art exhibitions, collaborations, talks, seminars and screenings. The Modern Language Experiment provides opportunities for both emerging and established artists, with the intention of engaging a broad and diverse audience, increasing awareness of contemporary visual art in our city and beyond.

The Modern Language Experiment will be using this opportunity to discuss Artist practice in relation to ideas of narrative art production. Keh and Matt will both present their latest works to be discussed in a critical context and will also be inviting a guest speaker to introduce current ideas related to narrative art production to the group.

Keh Hui Ng is a partner of the Modern Language Experiment and a visual artist interested in ideas pertaining to the propagation of urban myth. He considers the recounting of stories by those who were not present at actual events to be an integral reflection of what matters to us most. Keh has exhibited his works extensively in the UK, Australia and China.

Matthew Stock is a partner in the Modern Language Experiment and a video artist. His practice is concerned with the spaces for art, be it the artwork that is situated within it, the physical environment that

surrounds it, or the languages and peda gogy that is inherently linked to it. Matthew is interested in the circulation of the artwork, the gallery, the audience and the institution and how these categories are altered when divorced from time and place.
